Positivists believe society shapes the individual and use quantitative methods, intepretivists believe individuals shape society and use qualitative methods. This type of sociology is more interested in trends and patterns rather than individuals.Positivists also believe that sociology can and should use the same methods and approaches to study the social world that “natural” sciences such as biology and physics use to investigate the physical world. Interpretivism, also known as interpretivist involves researchers to interpret elements of the study, thus interpretivism integrates human interest into a study. Primary data generated via Interpretivism studies might be associated with a high level of validity because data in such studies tends to be trustworthy and honest. Positivism Positivists prefer quantitative methods such as social surveys, structured questionnaires and official statistics because these have good reliability and representativeness.Positivists see society as shaping the individual and believe that ‘social facts’ shape individual action.The positivist tradition stresses the importance of doing quantitative research such as large scale surveys in order to get an overview of society as a whole and to uncover social trends, such as the relationship between educational achievement and social class. According to interpretivist approach, it is important for the researcher as a social actor to appreciate differences between people.[3] Moreover, interpretivism studies usually focus on meaning and may employ multiple methods in order to reflect different aspects of the issue. The most noteworthy variations of interpretivism include the following: Hermeneutics refers to the philosophy of interpretation and understanding. In particular, we think about: (i) the central thesis of interpretivism that how humans act and behave is fundamentally different from how (e.g.) subatomic particles interact, and therefore needs a different method; (ii) the emergence of interpretivism as an alternative view to positivism in the nineteenth century, and the defence of positivism in the early twentieth with the work of Émile Durkheim, (iii) the work of Max Weber, whose sociological work combines the strengths of positivism and interpretivism in that his conclusions are both empirically testable (positivist) and makes sense in psychological terms (interpretivist), and (iv) two social phenomena which combine positivist and interpretivist analysis: the Protestant work ethic, and Gresham’s law. According to symbolic interactionism symbols provide the means by which reality is constructed In general interpretivist approach is based on the following beliefs: 1. Positivist prefer scientific quantitative methods, while Interpretivists prefer humanistic qualitative methods. In this type of studies, meanings emerge usually towards the end of the research process. This is known as the comparative method. This approach perceives reality as intersubjectively that is based on meanings and understandings on social and experiential levels. On the positive side, thanks to adoption of interpretivism, qualitative research areas such as cross-cultural differences in organizations, issues of ethics, leadership and analysis of factors impacting leadership etc. Hermeneutics mainly focuses on biblical texts and wisdom literature and as such, has a little relevance to business studies. & Thornhill, A. Interpretivism An Interpretivist approach to social research would be much more qualitative, using methods such as unstructured interviews or participant observationInterpretivists, or anti-positivists argue that individuals are not just puppets who react to external social forces as Positivists believe.According to Interpretivists individuals are intricate and complex and different people experience and understand the same ‘objective reality’ in very different ways and have their own, often very different, reasons for acting in the world, thus scientific methods are not appropriate.Interpretivist research methods derive from ‘social action theory’Interpretivists actually criticise ‘scientific sociology’ (Positivism) because many of the statistics it relies on are themselves socially constructed.Interpretivists argue that in order to understand human action we need to achieve ‘Verstehen’, or empathetic understanding – we need to see the world through the eyes of the actors doing the acting. Generally, if you are following interpretivism research philosophy in your dissertation the depth of discussion of research philosophy depends on the level of your studies. For a dissertation at Bachelor’s level it suffices to specify that you are following Interpretivism approach and to describe the essence of this approach in a short paragraph. Interpretivism is “associated with the philosophical position of idealism, and is used to group together diverse approaches, including social constructivism, phenomenology and hermeneutics; approaches that reject the objectivist view that meaning resides within the world independently of consciousness”[2].
