Interpretivist research methods derive from 'social action theory'Intereptivists actually criticise 'scientific sociology' (Positivism) because many of the statistics it relies on are themselves socially constructed. Interpretivists argue that in order to understand human action we need to see the world through the eyes of the actors doing the acting.
